SCHOLARSHIP NOTICE

Subject: Application for a Scholarship

Students of the *PKFokam Institute of Excellence* are hereby informed that the deadline for the submission of their scholarship applications is **Monday**, **April 28th**, **2025** at noon. The conditions and applications to be considered are the following:

1. Conditions for New Candidates:

- a) You have successfully completed the Preparatory Semesters of August-December 2024 (not repeating a course);
- **b)** GCE A level candidates: You must produce transcripts of the last three academic years in high school with at least three As and one B at the exam, including Maths and Physics; for Economics, the candidate must have scored at least three As and one B at the exam, including Economics;
- **e)** Baccalaureate candidates: You must produce transcripts of the last three academic years in secondary school with an overall average of at least 14/20.

2. Composition of Application Files for New Candidates

- a) A handwritten application addressed to the Chairman of the Scholarship Board of the PKFokam Institute of Excellence;
- b) Results of Competitive Entrance Exams (issued by the *PKFokam Institute of Excellence*);
- c) Results slip of the Preparatory Semester at the PKFokam Institute of Excellence;
- d) A copy of the candidate's birth certificate;
- e) A transcript copy of the Baccalaureate or GCE A/Level results;
- f) Transcript copies of the last three academic years as indicated above;
- g) A disciplinary statement (issued by the **PKFokam Institute of Excellence**);
- h) An undertaking by the candidate to serve Cameroon/Africa at the end of his/her studies;

3. Application for Scholarship Renewal

- a) A handwritten application addressed to the Chairman of the Scholarship Board of the PKFokam Institute of Excellence;
- b) An up-to-date transcript with a GPA of at least 3.
- c) A disciplinary statement (issued by the *PKFokam Institute of Excellence*).

4. <u>Students who score a minimum annual overall GPA of 3.6 the previous year</u> may apply for the Academic Excellence Scholarship in the current year even if they were not beneficiaries of the scholarship upon their first enrollment in PKFokam Institute of Excellence. The amount of the scholarship shall equally be determined by the applicants secondary school academic track record.

5. Types, requirements, and amounts of scholarships

A. Academic Excellence Scholarship: Scholarships for academic excellence shall be awarded to the 3 candidates with overall best performance at our July and August competitive entrance exams and who fulfill the following requirements:		Scholarship Amounts for each faculty

DECISION N°01/PKFokam-ADAF of May 21, 2024

Amending the policy of the PKFokam Institute of Excellence Scholarship Board

The PKFokam Institute of Excellence Scholarship Board,

Mindful of Ministerial Order N°02/0024/MINESUP of March 27th, 2002 on the Composition, Functioning, and Powers of the Administrative and Academic Bodies of Private Higher Education Institutions,

Mindful of Ministerial Decision N°07/00010/MINESUP of February 26th, 2007 accrediting the PKFokam Institute of Excellence,

Mindful of the Decision of the Appropriate Development for Africa Foundation (ADAF) to create the PKFokam Institute of Excellence Scholarship Board for the purpose of promoting African academic excellence and providing financial assistance to students from less privileged homes,

Mindful of Law $N^{\circ}2023/007$ of July 25^{th} , 2023 on the Orientation of Higher Education in Cameroon,

Mindful of Decision N°01/PKFokam of April 11th, 2024 reorganizing the Governance Bodies of PKFokam Institute of Excellence

Considering Board of Trustees Memorandum N° 02/KF/PBT/PKFIE/24 of April 25th, 2024 on upholding the standard of excellence

Hereby decides as follows:

<u>Article 1</u>. With effect from the 2024 Fall Semester, students who chose to pursue and complete their studies in partner universities in the United States of America shall no longer be eligible for scholarships.

Article 2. The PKFokam Institute of Excellence Scholarship Board shall consider as a priority only scholarship applications from students who undertake and agree to pursue and complete their studies on the PKFokam Institute of Excellence campus in Yaounde, Cameroon.

Article 3. All the other requirements to qualify for a scholarship shall still apply.

<u>Article 4</u>. This decision shall be given the widest publication by the authorities of PKFokam Institute of Excellence.
